

PRAYER BOOT CAMP RESPONSIBILITIES

7/12/24.

Responsibilities of the Host Church:

1. Provide a facility for the Prayer Boot Camp (PBC).
2. The format for the PBC could be half day, morning – afternoon, full day – morning, afternoon, evening, and/or weekend retreat. (If this option is chosen, the host church/ministry will need to secure the facility and make the necessary accommodations for food, lodging, etc.)
3. Drinks and snacks for the breaks; Lunch for PBCs extending beyond half day.
4. Sound and video equipment for worship and video and Power Point presentation.
5. A worship leader/band.
6. Two tables for registration and materials. There will be a registration fee to cover the cost of the PBC Training Manual.
7. Note: Men for Nations is providing the Prayer Boot Camp at no additional cost to the host. We ask the host to receive a free-will offering at the conclusion of the meeting to give the men an opportunity to “*Pay-it-Forward*”, for the men of the next PBC. This offering will be used to continue providing PBCs across the nation.
8. The host will commit to the 21-day prayer following the Prayer Boot Camp and provide a person to lead the 21-day prayer.

Responsibilities of Men for Nations:

1. Personnel to lead the Prayer Boot Camp.
2. Computers for video and Power Point presentations.
3. The Training Manuals for those attending.
4. NOTE: Men for Nations will continue to support and encourage the local Prayer Leader and his men after the Prayer Boot Camp through the men4nations.org website, offering Prayer Points on current events for the men to pray, one on one calls, conference calls, mentoring, facilitating DC trips, giving, and receiving prayer praise reports, and more.

Prayer Boot Camp Core Values

Pro-life, pro-traditional marriage & family values, Bible-based, multi-racial, multi-cultural, non-sectarian but not apolitical (pray for Godly government).

Expected Outcomes.

- A permanent group of men in that location who will be God's watchmen, consistently interceding for family, church, community, state, nation, and world.
